Duties & Responsibilities:

- Measures ingredients and prepares them in accordance to Air North Flight Kitchen standards and specifications
- Undertake basic cooking duties such as sautéing, grilling, baking, parboiling food etc.
- Receives deliveries and stores food in refrigerators, freezers, and dry store room. Accepts or rejects ingredients from food suppliers based on their appearance and quality
- Labels and stocks all ingredients on shelves so that they are organized and easily accessible, and ensures all food and other items are stored properly
- Washes, peels, and chops ingredients in order for them to be used in meal preparation
- Keeps track of ingredient quantities and ensures that there is always enough for the day/week
- Informs supervisor and/or lead when the ingredients stock is getting low or when equipment or kitchen tools are not working properly
- Cleans and sanitizes the working surfaces, utensils, equipment, and working areas
- Carefully monitors the temperatures of the cooler and freezer rooms to ensure that the ingredients are kept at the appropriate temperatures
- Maintains the kitchen by sanitizing prep areas before and after use and making sure that all knives and critical equipment are clean
- Performs other kitchen duties such as dish washing to assist the catering team

Job Requirements/Qualifications:

- Proven experience as a prep cook
- Knowledge of health and safety rules in a kitchen
- Comfortable working in a fast-paced environment with an ability to stay positive under pressure
- Knowledge of kitchen equipment, tools, and utensils. Able to work with steaming pots, pans with high heat temperatures, sharp utensils, slicing equipment, etc.
- Strong communication and learning skills with the ability to work as a team and follow verbal instructions
- Very good physical condition and endurance
- Demonstrates a passion for the culinary arts and takes pride in their work
